EXPLANATORY NOTE

Pursuant to General Instruction E to Form S-8 under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended (the Securities Act), this Registration Statement is filed by Exact Sciences Corporation, a Delaware corporation (the Company or Registrant), for the purpose of registering 2,000,000 additional shares of the Company s common stock, par value \$0.01 per share (the Common Stock), for offer and sale under the Exact Sciences Corporation 2010 Employee Stock Purchase Plan, as amended (the 2010 Plan), pursuant to an amendment to the 2010 Plan approved by the Company s stockholders on July 28, 2016 (the Amendment). After taking into account the shares added by the Amendment, the aggregate number of shares of Common Stock that may be issued under the 2010 Plan is 2,800,000, which includes (i) 500,000 shares of Common Stock previously registered under the Registration Statement on Form S-8, File No. 333-211099, filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the SEC) on May 3, 2016 (the ESPP First Amendment Registration Statement) and (ii) 300,000 shares of Common Stock previously registered under the Registration Statement on Form S-8, File No. 333-168909, filed with the SEC on August 17, 2010 (the ESPP Original Registration Statement and, together with the ESPP First Amendment Registration Statement, the Original Registration Statements). Pursuant to Instruction E to Form S-8, the Company hereby incorporates the Original Registration Statements by reference.

The Company is incorporated under the laws of the State of Delaware. Section 145 (Section 145) of the Delaware General Corporation Law, as the same exists or may hereafter be amended (DGCL), provides, among other things, that a Delaware corporation may indemnify any persons who were, are or are threatened to be made, parties to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative (other than an action by or in the right of such corporation), by reason of the fact that such person is or was an officer, director, employee or agent of such corporation, or is or

was serving at the request of such corporation as a director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation or enterprise. The indemnity may include expenses (including attorneys fees), judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by such person in connection with such action, suit or proceeding, provided such person acted in good faith and in a manner he reasonably believed to be in or not opposed to the corporation s best interests and, with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe that his conduct was illegal.

Section 145 further authorizes a corporation to purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation, or is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation or enterprise, against any liability asserted against him and incurred by him in any such capacity, arising out of his status as such, whether or not the corporation would otherwise have the power to indemnify him under Section 145.

The Company s certificate of incorporation provides that, except to the extent that the DGCL prohibits the elimination or limitation of liability of directors for breaches of fiduciary duty, directors of the Company shall not be personally liable to the Company or its stockholders for monetary damages for any breach of their fiduciary duty as directors except (i) for any breach of the director s duty of loyalty to the Company or its stockholders, (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a known violation of law, (iii) under Section 174 of the DGCL or (iv) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper impersonal benefit. In addition, the certificate of incorporation of the Company provides that the Company shall indemnify each person who was or is a party, or is threatened to be made a party to, any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative, by reason of the fact that such person is or was, or has agreed to become, one of the Company s directors or officers or is or was serving, or has agreed to serve, at the Company s request as a director, officer or trustee of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, employee benefit plan or other enterprise, against all expenses, including attorney s fees, judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by such person in connection with such action, suit or proceeding and any appeal therefrom, if he acted in good faith and in a manner he reasonably believed to be in, or not opposed to, the best interests of the Company, and with respect to any criminal action or proceeding, had no reasonable cause to believe his conduct was unlawful.

All of the Company s directors and officers are covered by insurance policies maintained by the Company against specified liabilities for actions taken in their capacities as such, including liabilities under the Securities Act.
