Barrier value: For each underlying, 60% of its initial underlying value
For each \$1,000 stated principal amount security you hold at maturity:

- If the final underlying value of the worst performing underlying is **greater than or equal to** its initial underlying value: $\$1,000 + \text{the return amount}$, subject to the maximum return at maturity
- If the final underlying value of the worst performing underlying is **less than** its initial underlying value but **greater than or equal to** its barrier value: \$1,000

Payment at Maturity: · If the final underlying value of the worst performing underlying is **less than** its barrier value: $\$1,000 + (\$1,000 \times \text{the underlying return of the worst performing underlying})$

Selected Risk Considerations
