(8) This option was granted on December 4, 2015 as an option for either 100,000 shares of Class A Common Stock at an exercise price of \$7.39 per share or 100,000 shares of Class C Common Stock at an exercise price of \$7.39 per share, or any combination thereof. This option reflects the reporting person's election to have an option for 100,000 shares of Class C Common Stock at an exercise price of \$7.39 per share, but adjusted pursuant to the anti-dilution provisions of the 2013 Stock Option Plan to reflect a 5% stock dividend paid on February 5, 2016. The option vests in four quarterly installments of Class C Common Stock, beginning on March 4, 2016, until such shares are fully vested.
