- (1) The sale reported in this Form 4 was effected pursuant to a Rule 10b5-1 trading plan established by the reporting person on June 7, 2010. These options were granted on October 30, 2008 when the reporting person was employed by Coca-Cola Enterprises Inc. ("CCE"). Pursuant to the Business Separation and Merger Agreement dated February 25, 2010 by and among CCE, International CCE, Inc., The Coca-Cola Company and Cobalt Subsidiary LLC (the "Merger Agreement"), the outstanding options to purchase shares of CCE's common stock were cancelled as of October 2, 2010 at 12:01 a.m. and converted to that number of options to purchase Common Stock of The Coca-Cola Company obtained by multiplying the number of outstanding options granted by CCE by 0.53788904. The exercise price of each outstanding CCE option was adjusted by multiplying the exercise price by 1.85911950.
- (2) Common Stock of The Coca-Cola Company obtained by multiplying the number of outstanding options granted by CCE by 0.53788904. The exercise price of each outstanding CCE option was adjusted by multiplying the exercise price by 1.85911950.
