The option grant was approved by the Compensation/Stock Option Committee on December 6, 2007, subject to shareholder approval of (1) the Valassis Communications, Inc. 2008 Omnibus Incentive Compensation Plan. Valassis' shareholders approved this Plan on April 24, 2008.

This option becomes exercisable in increments of 33.3333%, 33.3333% and 33.3334% at such time that the closing sales price per (2) common share is equal to or exceeds \$16.69, \$21.69 and \$26.69, respectively; provided that such market price targets are achieved by January 1, 2011. In any event, however, the option vests by January 1, 2013.
