Vesting of the Performance Stock Units is dependent on the relative total shareholder return ("TSR") of Plexus Corp.'s common stock during a three-year performance period (fiscal 2014 through fiscal 2016) as compared to the Russell 3000 Index. The target number of Performance Stock Units that may be earned is reported above; the maximum amount is 200% of the number reported.

(8) Options granted under the Plexus Corp. 2008 Long-Term Incentive Plan, or a predecessor plan, which qualifies under Rule 16b-3; now fully vested.
