- (1) This represents a restricted stock award. All 8,600 Shares vest on 2/22/2011.

Total Shareholder Return is calculated by adding the changes in a company's closing stock price between December 30, 2007 and December 31, 2010 to any dividends paid during that period, and is adjusted for any stock splits or dividends.
