1. On April 1, 2001, Consumers Energy Company ("Consumers"), a wholly owned public utility subsidiary of CMS Energy, transferred its ownership interest in certain transmission facilities to Michigan Electric Transmission Company ("Michigan Transco"), pursuant to an agreement between Consumers and Michigan

2. In exchange for the transmission facilities, Consumers received all of the common stock of Michigan Transco.
